Monthly Flash Report January 2020



The Purpose of this report is to sum-up the activities, services and products delivered by the Project in January 2020

Fiscal Decentralisation

- On 24 January, project expert Tony Levitas presented the international experience of municipal fiscal equalisation and possible approaches to changes in Ukraine to the colleagues from MinFin and state oblast administrations at an event organized by the Ukrainian Ministry of Finance.
- On 24 January, project expert Tony Levitas met with the Swedish Ambassador and representatives of Sida in Kyiv to discuss the latest developments in the field of fiscal decentralisation in Ukraine.
- Project experts continued cooperation with the Ministry of Finance on municipal financial equalisation, with two meetings held in January.
- Expert of the National Office of Reforms, Igor Gerasymchuk, carried out the following activities in January:
- Range of analyses of the local government financial data (both revenues and expenditures) comparing data for 11 months of 2018 and 2019 with key indicators. Analysis was usually coupled with development

- of graphic materials to showcase the results.
- Analysis of the distribution of additional subsidies for education and medicine by regional state administrations in local budgets in 2020.
- Participation in the preparation of the monthly brochure "Monitoring the process of decentralization of power and reform of local self-government" with indicators for 11 months of 2018 and 2019 including new diagrams and information.
- Support to development and application of software "Calculation of financial capacity of perspective AHs".
- Preparation of analysis of the legislation of Ukraine regarding the single tax, individual taxpayer numbers and the approach to collection of personal income tax.
- Preparation of analytical materials on excise duty on fuel in 806 AHs for the 11 months of 2019.

Decentralisation of Education Work on national level

- During January 2020, the work of the education decentralisation team focused on:
- Guidance and support to the MES with introduction of the most recent student data in the education subvention allocation mechanism.
- Update of an electronic (MS Excel based) "Simulator" tool for allocation of the Education Subvention from State to local budgets to accommodate the transition of data use.
- Finalisation of analysis of the aggregated education subvention transfers across treasury accounts of all sub-national actors.
- Finalisation of the analytical paper describing Changes in Networks of Secondary Schools in Ukraine over 2017-2019.
- Establishment of the new direction of work on an-

- alytical support to MES in design of the structure, composition and approaches to the salary reform of pedagogical staff.
- On the job training for the team of the Ministry of Education and the Institute of Education Analytics responsible for the performance monitoring of the use of education subvention by local governments.
- On 24 January meeting of Ambassador of Sweden to Ukraine with Minister of Education Anna Novosad on Swedish cooperation with Ukraine developing education in hromadas.
- Senior expert on Education prepared and submitted to MES leadership the following analytical papers:
