Fiscal Decentralisation

In July-August, the Fiscal Decentralisation team worked on the following tasks:

- On July 6 meeting with the Minister Of Education and Science of Ukraine and discussed the results of cooperation and future plans
- On 08 July presentation of the book "Paying the Teachers: Three Case Studies of Reforming National Systems of Teacher Remuneration in Eastern Europe"
- On 09 July meeting of the working group in the Ministry of Finances of Ukraine on improvement of the Education subvention formula
- Preparation for the new activity education budgeting on local level. The objective is to make the budget process shorter and better

Decentralisation of Education (local level)

Local education component focused on:

- On 08 July, Launch of the Project's support to education management in hromadas and oblasts Lviv
- On 17 August, Launch of the Project's support to education management in hromadas and oblasts -Poltava
- Updating of the country-wide database of contacts of local education managers
- Working on the new best practices in hromadas. During the reporting period 2 new practices were uploaded on the web-page
- Preparation for the next seminar Launch of the Project's support to education management in hromadas and oblasts - Zhytomyr (planned for 8 September)
- The experiences of gender audits in education are being investigated to see if and how they could be
 used in the work of the component. There is a plan to carry out gender audit in MES and develop
 guidelines for gender audits for wider application. Preparations are underway
- On 26 August project exprets met with the Ukrainian Institute of Education Development (UIED) on further cooperation
- On 27 July Donor coordination meeting on education took place. Discussion was about the training products which different projects develop for hromadas
